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Deprivation

- 3. To find out the different deprivation scores across the Waikato region, select the 'Demographics' tab at the top of the tool.
- You will then need to adjust the filter to show specifically what you are looking for.
 E.g. If you are looking for all high deprivation areas within the Waikato region, you will need to select the below options:
 - a. Choose Region Type: "Regional Sports Trust"
 - b. Choose Region: "Waikato"
 - c. Choose Measure for Map: "Population"
 - d. Choose Demographic Category for Map: "All"
 - e. Choose Deprivation Level: "High (8-10)"



5. You will then need to select the correct cursor to be able to move the map around, enabling you see different districts and to zoom in. To do this, you need to hover over the map to enable the 'toolbar' to appear on the left-hand side of the map.

 - button.
- More options will appear, and you will need to click the button.

Decile

- 8. To find out the different decile ratings at schools within the Waikato region, select the 'School Profiles' tab at the top of the tool.
- You will then need to adjust the filter to show specifically what you are looking for.
 E.g. If you are looking for all low decile schools within the Waikato region, you will need to select the below options:
 - a. Choose Region Type: "Regional Sports Trust"
 - b. Choose Region: "Waikato"
 - c. Choose Decile Band: "Low Decile (1-3)"
- 10. You will then need to select the correct cursor to be able to move the map around, enabling you see different districts and to zoom in. To do this, you need to hover over the map to enable the 'toolbar' to appear on the left-hand side of the map.

11. You then need to click the button
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12. More options will appear, and you will need to click the button.

You can now move the map around by clicking and dragging. To zoom, you can either use the zoom function on the 'toolbar', the plus or minus, or you can use the scroll wheel on your mouse while hovering over the map.
