

APPLYING FOR TŪ MANAWA FUNDING?

YOU WILL NEED TO COLLECT VOICE OF THE
PARTICIPANT. FIND OUT HOW!

WHAT IS VOICE OF THE PARTICIPANT?

VOP is evidence directly from the participants (ie: tamariki/rangatahi) that shows **they want** the project/activity you plan to deliver.

You need to be able to show that this opportunity is something that **they have asked for**.

WHAT IS NOT CONSIDERED VOICE OF THE PARTICIPANT?

- Requests or feedback from parents, teachers, coaches etc.
- Enrolment, registration information and numbers

COMMON WAYS TO GATHER VOICE OF THE PARTICIPANT:

- Participant survey results
- Videos (verbal requests)
- Written requests
- Quotes from participants (verbal/written)
- Feedback
- Social media polls
- Classroom polls or informal surveys



WHAT TO INCLUDE IN THE APPLICATION

Include as much information/VOP as possible!

Gather hard evidence from your participants about **what they want** and **why they want it**.

Include what your tamariki and rangatahi want to be doing and how you know this.
